



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the West Side of Water Street in the Town of York containing in Front on said Street fifty seven feet and an half and in length to Codorus Creek two hundred and twenty feet Bounded Eastward with Water Street aforesaid Southward with a Lot of Ground in the Tenure of Jacob Doudle marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and thirty nine Westward with Codorus Creek and Northward with a Lot of Ground in the Tenure of Jacob Doudle and marked on the Genl Plan aforesaid Number One hundred and thirty seven.

Entered on the Plan of the said Town and Surveyed for Jacob Doudle who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of settling the Town.

Certified at York the 2^d day of April 1759.
