County containing 1100<sup>acs</sup> and the usual allowance for roads. Surveyed <sup>July</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> 1793 for Charles Willing, in persuance of a warrant Dated April 11<sup>th</sup> 1792 No. 1095.
