



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Marlborough Township formerly by mistake called Limerick, in the county of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing one hundred and three acres, and 124 perches of land, together with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads. That was formerly surveyed to George Peter Knecht, in Pursuance of a warrant granted to him by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries of This Province. Dated on the 31<sup>st</sup> May, Anno. 1738. Resurveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> June Anno. 1774. By order of the Surveyor General.
