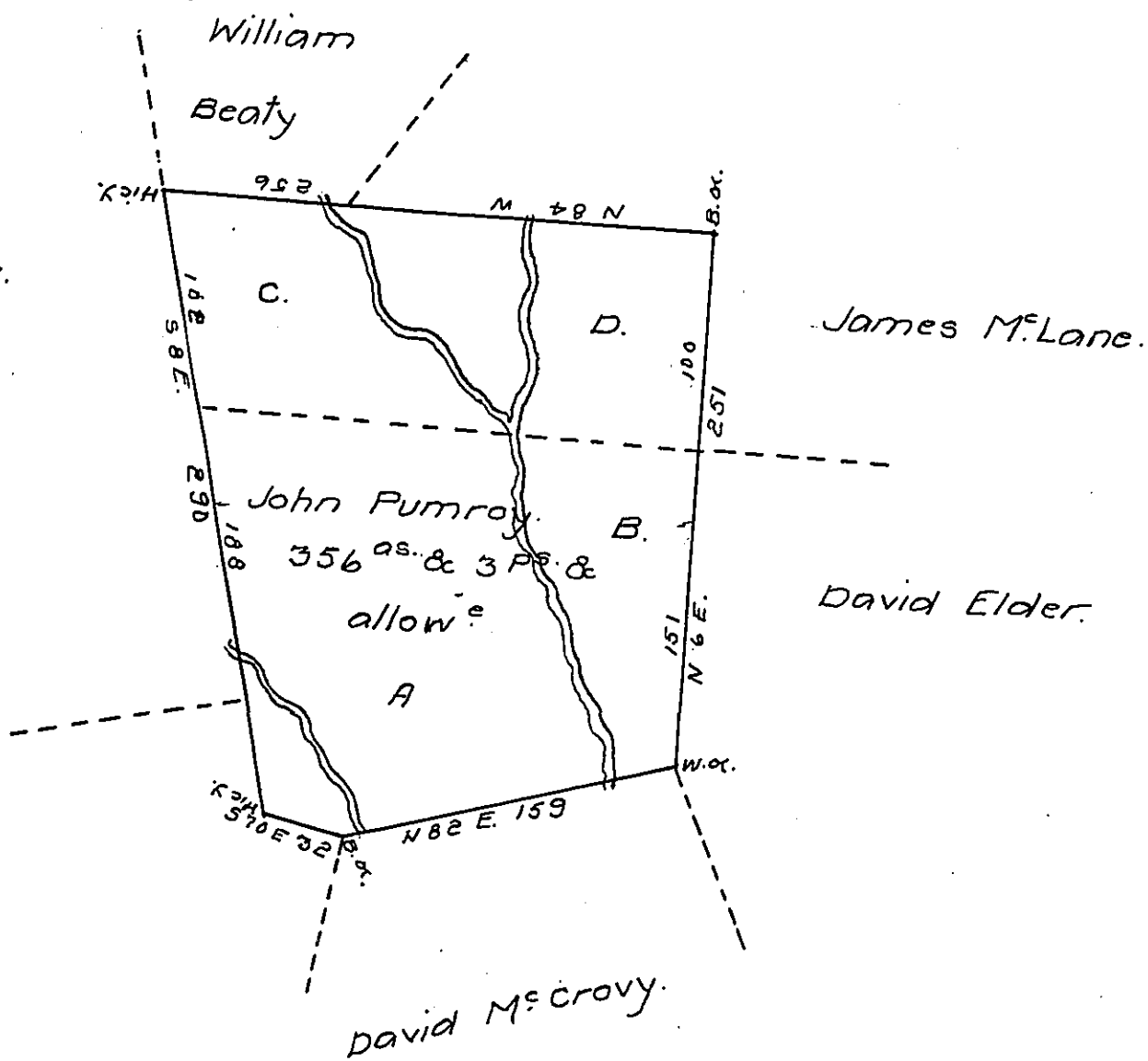


James M^cLane.



Survey^d to John Pumroy (in right of John Stevenson) on the 22^d of April, 1773. The above described tract of three hundred and fifty six acres, and three perches and allowance of six p^r Cent & c. situate on Stony Run including an improvement adjoining lands of James M^cLane, David M^cCrovy and others now Centre Township Indiana County. By order of the 3^d day of Apr^l 1769, N.B. That part of the above survey as represented by the dotted line and the letters A & B. was survey^d to Stephen Porter on the 24th of Nov^r 1775 by his warrant of the eighth of Dec^r 1774, that part of the above survey as represented by the dotted line & the letters C. & D. was surveyed to William Beaty on the 16th of Aprile 1786, By virtue of his War^t dated the 1st of July 1784
