



Surveyed to John Pumroy in ~~the~~ right of John Stevenson ~~on the~~ on the 22^d of Aprile 1773. The above described Tract of Three hundred and fifty-six acres and three perches and allowance of six per cent situate on Stony Run including an improvement adjoining lands of James McLain, David McLcrovy and others in Westmoreland (now Indiana) County, Center Township by order of the third day of Aprile 1769.

N.B. That part of the above survey as represented by the dotted line & the letters A. & B. was surveyed to Stephen Porter on the 24th of Nov^r 1775 by his warrant of the 8th of December 1774, that part of above survey as represented by the dotted line & ^{the letters} C. & D. was surveyed to William Beaty on the 16th of Aprile 1786, by warrant of the 1st of July 1784.

The above described tract of land was surveyed by Joshua Elder at the time above mentioned but was not returned until now that I have examined ⁱⁿ the lines on the ground on the 22^d day of May 1811 and find them to be exact accurate and have returned it
