also I John Watters of the afore said County and
State Seat Soldier Commanded by Genl Richard Butler
of this Regiment for Divers good Causes and Considerations
as hereunto Moving Have Made ordained and authorize
and appointed and by these Presents Do Make ordain
and authorize and appoint Andrew ~~McDonough~~
True and Lawfull attorney for us and in our Names
and for our uses to ask Demand and obtain the Ration
for the Land allowed us for our services in the Seat
of the federal army of america to the End of the war we
Do appoint the said Andrew ~~McDonough~~ to act for us
as if we were personally Present in every Part
Respecting the afore said Land allowed us for our
services to the End of the war by vertue of this
Presents in witness whereof we have set our
Hands and seals in one thousand seven Hundred
and Eighty Nine August 14: 1789
