 State of Pennsylvania, have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents
 do make, constitute, and appoint, and in my place and stead, just and depute
 James Fumble Esq. of the Borough of Lancaster, to apply at the Land office of this
 Commonwealth, for me and in my name, to procure a pattant for two hundred
 acres of Donation Land, Done one as a private, in the Pennsylvania line, during
 the war with England, and to do all Lawful acts and things whatsoever concerning
 the premises as fully in every respect as I myself might or could do if I were person-
 ally present, hereby Ratifying and allowing all and whatsoever my said attorney
 shall in my name Lawfully do in and about the premises, by virtue of these pre-
 sents; In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the fourth
 Day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and one
