 Esquire of Centre County (late Millin) and State of Pennsylvania
 my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name
 to make application for return and process for fine
 and in my name a warrant for what portion land in
 due form by the State of Pennsylvania for my services in
 the Army in the 4th Light Dragoon Regiment from the
 13th day of March 1778 until the 30th day of June 1783
 by writing and granting unto my said attorney by his
 parents my full and whole power strength and authority
 to do in and about the premises to have, use
 take all lawful ways and means in my name for the
 execution of aforesaid and generally all and every
 act or acts thing and things whatsoever needful and
 necessary to be done in and about the premises for me and
 in my name to do, execute and perform so fully largely and
 amply to all intents and purposes as if myself might
 or could do. I personally present at the doing thereof and
 approve me or more under him for the purpose aforesaid
 to make and execute and again at pleasure to revoke
 hereby ratifying, allowing and holding for him and good
 all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do
 in and about the premises by virtue hereof in
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the
 1st day of December in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and two - 5th of July
