Know all Men by these Presents, That I Alexander Boyd (of late a Soldier in the Continental Army) For and in Consideration of the Sum of Five Shillings Lawful Money of Pennsylvania to me in Hand well & truly paid by George Frey of Paxton Township in the County of Dauphin and State of Pennsylvania (Whose Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) and for other good Causes and Considerations me thereunto moving, Have granted, bargained & sold, released, assigned & confirmed & by these Presents do grant bargain & sell, release assign & confirm unto the said George Frey his Heirs & Assigns for ever, all my Right Title Interest Claim & Demand, whatsoever in and to that Lot of Land which at drawing of the Lottery may come to me (in consequence of an Act for the purpose ~~making~~ of rewarding Soldiers & made) And I request the Comptroller General J. Nicholas Esq. to Order & direct that the said Piece of Land which as above said may be allotted to me, be granted and confirmed unto the said George Frey his Heirs & Assigns for ever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & seal the Eleventh day of September A.D. one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven.
