

Know all men By these Presents, That I *John Brown* formerly a private soldier in the 9<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania

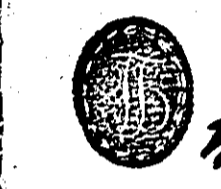
in the service of the United States of America, for value and the full consideration money, to him  
in hand paid, at, and before the execution hereof by *Stedrick Mollenau*  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE, and hereby Do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, con-  
vey and confirm unto *Stedrick Mollenau* heirs, executors,  
administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity,  
which I now have, or which I may hereafter have, or administrators, may hereafter have  
to the lands, pay, depreciation, clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize-moneys, and every  
other arrears, claim and demand whatever, due and owing *to me* from and by the United States or  
any particular State, and I do hereby for my heirs, executors and administrators con-  
sent and agree, to and with the said *Stedrick Mollenau* heirs,  
executors, administrators and assigns that I may hereafter, will, at any  
time hereafter, at the reasonable cost and charges of *Stedrick Mollenau*  
heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assur-  
ances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the  
premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make, constitute and ap-  
point *Stedrick Mollenau* and lawful attorney, irrevocably to demand and receive, sue for, and recover from the United States,  
or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority,  
all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and sold, and now  
whith and detained from me by the United States or State of Pennsylvania  
with power, also, attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts  
equitable for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or  
no substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.

that it might be recorded as such.

whatever, due and owing to me from and by the United States

the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above  
recited and sold, and now whith and detained from me by  
the United States or State of Pennsylvania with power, also,  
attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute,  
and to do all lawful acts equitable for effecting the premises,  
hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or  
no substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
