according to Law; and make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods, Chattels, and Credits of the said Deceased, which have, may, or shall come to your Hands, Possession or Knowledge, appraised in Money; and a true and just Account of and upon your Administration therein; and to exhibit both into our said Office for registering of Wills for the COUNTY of *Cecil* aforesaid; touching which Inventory you are presently assigned to perform, or, at furthest, at or before the *Fifteenth* Day of *September* now next ensuing, and an Account within Twelve Months from the Date of these Presents; and lastly, we do hereby constitute and appoint you the said *John McLean* Administrator of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased.—GIVEN at *Chapelton* this *Eighteenth* Day of *June* in the Year of our Lord, Seventeen Hundred and Eighty-
