and say that to his certain knowledge, the Bearer hereof Timothy  
Brown is to be a private Soldier, in Col. Thompson's Regiment, in the  
year 1775, when he marched to Boston, that he afterwards Timothy  
Brown is to be a Soldier in the Third Pennsylvania Regiment in the  
Service of the United States, and that he continued in the said  
Service until the end of the said War to the best of his knowledge  
and further this Deponent feithfully
