and State of Pennsylvania Farmer, have named and
constituted, and by their presents do name and ordain
and appoint, and make Major James W. Belmont of
the Township of Lutterkenny County & State above named
Farmers, my true and Lawfull Attorney, for me, and in
my name, and to my use to draw by lot that portion,
tract, or lot of Land, to which I am entitled, according to
a Law of the commonwealth of the State aforesaid, in
such case made and provided, giving and hereby granting
unto my said Attorney my full Power and Authority, to do
and execute all such acts, things and services in the Law
as shall be necessary for recovering, or ascertaining the lot
of Land due to me, as a late Soldier of Pennsylvania
and to make and give Acquittances, or other sufficient
discharges, or perform such customary acts as are in
such case required by Law, in my name, and generally
to do and execute in the premises, as fully as myself
might or could do, being personally present, and giving
confirming, and allowing all, and whatsoever my said
Attorney shall Lawfully do, or cause to be done therein, by
virtue of this present, in testimony whereof, I have hereunto
