Donation Land

To all Persons to whom these Presents shall come,
KNOW YE, That I, Jacob Cable late a
Soldier & Corporal in the first Pennsylvania Regiment

in the service of the United States of America, for and in consideration of the sum of
fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States
to me in hand paid, at and before the enrolling and delivery of these Presents, by
David Whitehead of the City and State of New York
Have sold, remised, released, quit-claimed, transferred, and assigned, and by these Pre-
sents, do sell, remise, release, quit-claim, transfer, and assign, to the said *David*
Whitehead his Heirs and Assigns for ever, all the right, title, interest,
claim and demand, which I now have, and all right and title, interest, claim and de-
claim and demand, which I, my Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, at any time hereafter may
have, to all the land which I am intitled to, and to all the land which *State of Pennsylvania*
they may at any time hereafter be intitled to, from the *Congress of the United*
States of America, for my services as a *Soldier* in the Army of the United
States of America, for during the War with Great Britain, and to every part and
parcel thereof: And I the said *Jacob Cable* do, for myself,
my Heirs, Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, hereby covenant and agree, to
and with the said *David Whitehead* my Heirs, Execu-
tors, Administrators, or Assigns, that I the said *Jacob Cable* my Heirs, Execu-
tors, Administrators, or Assigns, shall and will at any time or times hereafter, at the
request, cost and charges of the said *David Whitehead* his Heirs, or As-
signs, do make, seal, and execute, or cause or procure to be made, done, sealed and
executed, all and every such reasonable act and acts, thing and things, conveyance
and conveyances, assurance and assurances in the law whatsoever, for the perfect
granting, conveying, remising, releasing, transferring, and assigning, all and singular
the right, title, interest, claim and demand, which I the said *Jacob Cable*
my Heirs, Executors, or Administrators have, or may at any
time hereafter have, of, in and to the land aforesaid; and of, in and to every part and
parcel thereof, unto the said *David Whitehead* his Heirs and
Assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said *David Whitehead*
his Heirs and Assigns forever, as by his or their counsel, learned in the law, shall be
reasonably advised or devised or required: And I the said *Jacob Cable*
do hereby appoint the said *David Whitehead* my true and lawful At-
torney, or otherwise one or more Attornies under him, irrevocably, to ask, demand,
solicit, and obtain in my name, or otherwise; but for the sole use and behoof of the
said *David Whitehead* his Heirs and Assigns, forever, from the
Office of the United States, a grant or grants, patent or patents, for the land
aforesaid; hereby ratifying and confirming, all and whatsoever my said Attorney or
his substitute or substitutes may do respecting the same. And I the said *Jacob*
Cable for myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators,
do covenant, promise and agree with the said *David Whitehead*
his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, that I will not revoke or annul
the Power of Attorney herein contained; or do any act, which shall impede the said
David Whitehead in soliciting or obtaining a grant or grants,
patent or patents, for the land aforesaid.
