 are due which are or shall be due being payable and belonging  
 to me or detained from me by any manner or means what-  
 soever by the United States or the State of Pennsylvania or any other  
 Person or Persons acting under their Authority and I do give and  
 Grant unto my true Attorney full Power and Authority  
 fully to sell and Dispose of all and singuler the Lands Tenements  
 Grants and Donations which I am entitled to, or of right  
 may claim in Virtue of any Act of the United States in Congress  
 assembled or under the Authority of the State of Pennsylvania  
 or by Reason of my having served in the said first & second Regts  
 of the Pennsylvania Line and by good and sufficient Assurances  
 in the said Regt of my true Attorney and Confirmer to the Purchase  
 of the said Regt of my true Attorney and Confirmer to the Purchase  
 Granting unto my true Attorney full power and Authority  
 to Appoint one or more Attorneys under his or their  
 full power of my true Attorney and Confirmer all  
 and singular whatsoever my said Attorney shall or  
 may do in the premises by Virtue hereof
