my attorney and well beloved friend John C. Jones of
Quincy County, South Carolina, my true and lawful
attorney for me and in my name and to my use to
do all and whatsoever shall lawfully do or cause to be
done in my name and to my use touching the above
premises by these presents. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Harrisburg in
Quincy County the twenty eighth day of July 1887

Thomas Campbell of Franklin County was
appointed a capt in the Spring Camps in 1796
was taken prisoner at Fort Mifflin and not
exchanged till 1798. He was then appointed to the
command of a Mifflin Company in the frontier
of West Maryland County & continued in that
service till the Spring of 1799 during which time
he suffered vic? clothing, shoes, sugar, & other
as any other circumstances in quantity but that
in Camp, Mifflin and the last two years had
no depreciation made up to him
