of the said County Personally appeared James
Caruthers Who upon his Solmn Oath Deposith that
Not long after the Commencement of the American Revo-
lution he enlisted as a Soldier in Captain James Moore
Company in the Pennsylvania line and continued in the
Service of his Country in the same Company untill he
was drafted into Captain Bonds Company of the
Infantry ^{in the fifth Regiment} Where he served faithfully untill he was
wounded at the Battle of Green Springs in Virginia -
after which he continued in the Hospital and under-
Cure during the Remainder of the War, and that he
has never Drawn the Lands due to him from the State
of Pennsylvania for his services as aforesaid. -
Sworn and subscribed the day & year aforesaid.
