This Indenture made the thirteenth day of
February, in the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and
Six, Between Joseph Armstrong, Junior, of Hamilton Township, Frank-
lin County, and State of Pennsylvania, of the one part, and George Arm-
strong, Esquire, of Greensburg, of the other part: Witnesseth that this
Joseph Armstrong, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty Dol-
lars to him in Hand paid by this George Armstrong, at or before
the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, released and con-
firmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, release
and confirm to this George Armstrong, his heirs and Assigns, all
that certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Cam-
ford, late Westminsterland, in the tenth district of Donation Lands
Beginning at a Sycamore tree numbered one, and running
East, by lot N. 2033, two hundred and sixty one perches, to a buck-
tree, thence South by lot N. 2040, one hundred and thirty perches
to a Beech tree, thence West, by lot N. 2025, two hundred and sixty one
perches, to a Beech tree, and thence North, by lot N. 90, one hundred
and thirty perches to a Sugar tree, the place of beginning, contain-
ing two hundred Acres and allowance of six Cent for Roads &c.
Numbered MMXXIV. Being the same Tract of Land, which the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by Patent, bearing date the thir-
tieth day of September A.D. 1707, Entered in the Office for Re-
cording of Deeds in and for the County of Allegheny in Book No. Vol.
2^d Page 309, granted unto William M. Shattin, - and which this
William M. Shattin and Jane his wife by Indenture, bearing date
the fifteenth day of November A.D. 1790, granted to this Joseph
