Guine also appeared before and being sworn as above deposed and saith that after the Battle of Brandywine it was reported that David Davis was either killed in said battle or taken prisoner, after the Battle of Monmouth in the year 1778 this deponent was sent to Carlisle in Pennsylvania where he saw the same David Davis a soldier employed in the British Army, and he remained so when this deponent marched to camp with the Elements, and was still in the service when he returned after the Battle of the Clouds in Virginia in the year 1781, and for as long ^{time} as he knows he believes he continued a soldier till he was discharged and that above named David Davis is the same man.
