granting to my said Attorney, my full and full power
and Authority, to follow such Courses, for the recovery,
Receiving and securing the same as I my self might or could
do were I personally present, and upon the Receipt of
same Acquittances, and Other sufficient discharges, for
me & in my Name, to make sign seal and deliver, And
further to do perform and finish for me & in my
Name, all singular thing or things, which shall or may
be necessary to be done, as Touching the premises, as
fully, thoroughly, and Entirely, as I the said Abraham
Dehart in my own person ought or could do in & about
the same. Ratifying and Confirming & allowing, what-
soever my said Attorney shall do, or cause to be done, in
& about the Execution of the premises by Virtue of these
