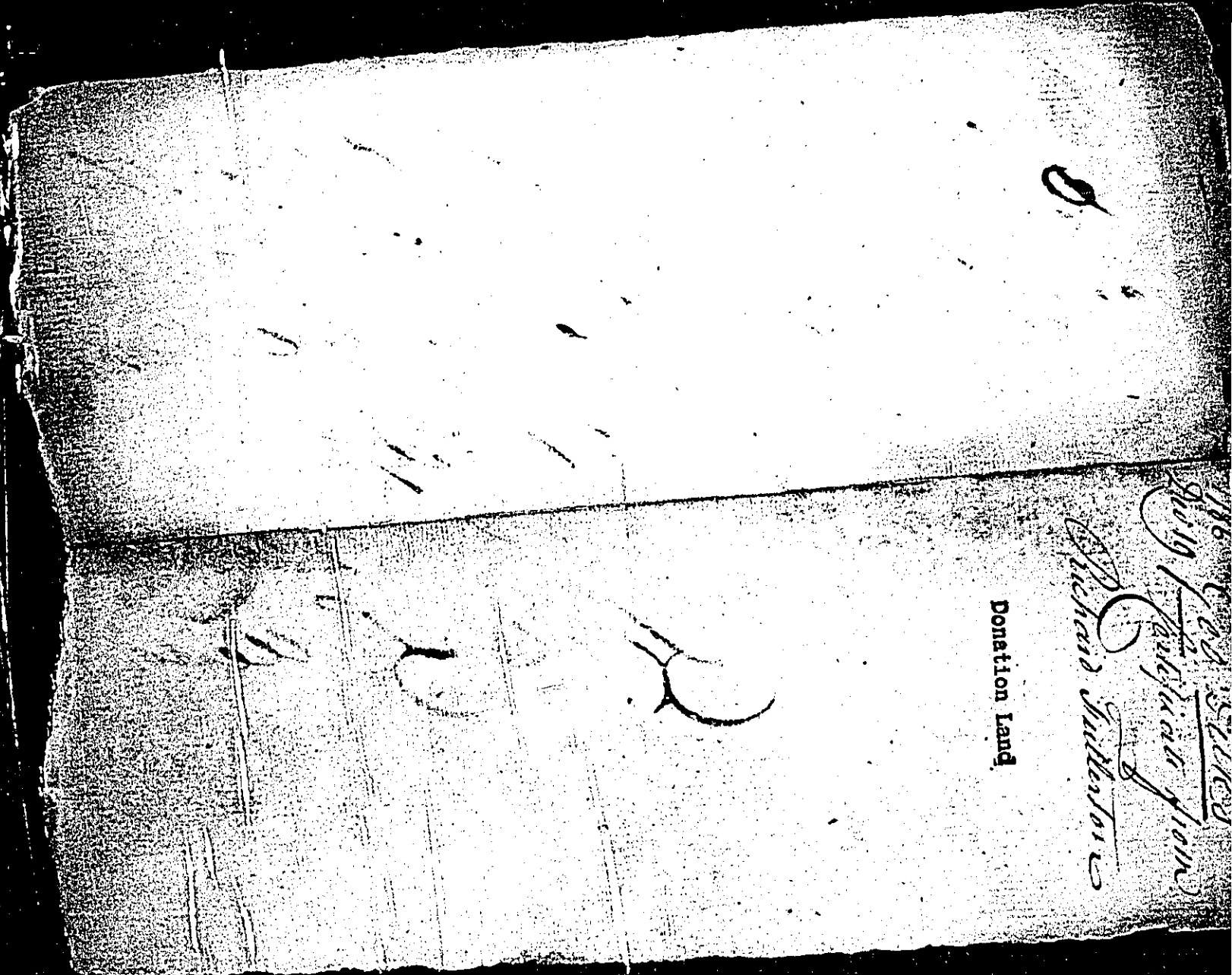


Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Dewes Late a sifer in the

Claiming or to Claim from by or under me. In Testimony
