

Know all men by these presents that I Abraham Dolton formerly of the County of Chester now of Montgomery State of Pennsylvania for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars above money of the State of Pennsylvania to me in hand well and truly paid before the execution hereof by Christian Hubbert of the City of Philadelphia house Carpenter the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold Released and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell Release and conform unto the said Christian Hubbert and to his heirs and assigns forever all my Estate Right and title Interest Use Property claims and demands of in and to Five pieces or tracts of donation lands each containing two hundred Acres Ye. 1793 One of them in the name of Jacob Henry late a soldier in the Pennsylvania line during the late war and the said Jacob Henry by deed poll under his hand and seal duly executed and bearing date the fifteenth day of October 1793 for the consideration therein mentioned died convey the same to the said Abraham Dolton and to his heirs and assigns forever one Other of them in the name of ~~Adam~~ Adam Rupert late soldier in the Pennsylvania line during the late War and the said Adam Rupert by deed poll under his hand and seal duly executed and bearing date the fifteenth day of October 1793 for the consideration therein mentioned died convey the same to the said Abraham Dolton and to his heirs and assigns forever, one of them in the name of Christian Baker late soldier in the Pennsylvania line during the late War and the said Christian Baker by deed poll under his hand and seal duly executed and bearing date the nineteenth day of September 1793 for the consideration therein mentioned died
