 land containing two Hundred Acres & Allowance of
 six $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ for Roads &c. In district N^o 2
 of Lot N^o 1871 And I do desire that the patent
 may Issue in the name and as the property of the
 said Samuel Pennycuik his heirs & assigns for ever
 & I do by these presents warrant & defend it from
 me my heirs & assigns for ever all and every other
 persons lawfully claiming from by or under
 me
