 of the Kingdom of Ireland Mounch Dixon wife of Wil-  
 liam Dixon Mugh McFarlane late of the Kingdom of  
 Ireland David McFarlane of Washington County and  
 Francis McFarlane of the County of Allegany in the  
 State of Pennsylvania of said are Co-heirs of the Estate  
 of the said James McFarlane Decedent aforesaid. And  
 whereas William Dixon and Hannah his wife of said by  
 their Deed called a Letter or paper of Attorney duly executed  
 in the Kingdom of Ireland bearing date the 24th day of  
 the month of March in the year of our said late King and
