 & James Gibbons do hereby empower my Brother
 in Law David Garmen to Receive all my pay
 Lands due to me the S^r James Gibbons for my
 Services as aforesaid and his Receipt shall be a full
 Discharge for me as witness my hand and Seal
 this 19th day of September 1792. —
