fealing and delivery) of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknow-
ledge Have granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed
an by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien release and con-
firm unto the said Daniel Vanosten and to his heirs and assigns for
ever all that certain Tract of Donation numbered **MMLCXXII**
in the tenth district of Donation Land formerly in the County of West-
moreland now in the County of Allegheny bounded and described as
follows viz Beginning at a Birch tree the numbered corner and
running East by lot number 2121 two hundred and sixty two perch-
es to a Beech tree thence south by lot number 2143 one hundred and
thirty perches to a Birch tree thence West by lot number 2123 two
hundred and sixty two perches to a Birch tree thence North by lot num-
ber 2115 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning
containing two hundred acres of Land and the usual allowance of six
acres per cent for roads and highways [Being the same tract of Land
and premises which was granted by Patent from the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania bearing date the twenty third day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six to
John Williams for his services as a private soldier in the Pennsylvania
Line of the late army of the United States - Who by his deed endorsed
upon the said Patent under his hand and seal bearing date the twen-
ty seventh day of December in the same year granted and conveyed
some tract of Land with the appurtenances unto me the said George
Gilbert in fee simple together with the appurtenances and the reversi-
ons and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and all my estate
right title interest property claim and demand whatsover in law
and equity of in and to the same To have and to hold the said
tract of two hundred acres of Land hereditaments and premises hereby
granted with the appurtenances unto the said Daniel Vanosten his
heirs
