by these presents, Grant bargain & Sell, Release &
Confer unto the said Jos. Johnston his heirs & assigns
for ever, a certain tract of Land in one of the Division
Districts in y^e County of Westmoreland containing two
Hundred Acres & Allowance of six P. Land for Roads &c
in District N^o. 4 of Lot N^o. 1423 & I do desire
that y^e patent may Issue in y^e name & as the property
of the said Jos. Johnston his heirs & assigns for ever and I
do by these presents warrant & defend it from my heirs
& assigns for ever all & every other persons lawfully claim-
ing from by or under me as Witness my hand & Seal this
