


Know all men by these Presents that I William

my attorney for me and in my name and for my use
to Receive from the State of Pennsylvania my
Donation Land due to me for the Services by
me Rendered as a Soldier in said line and
Army giving to my attorney full and ample
Power to Demand Receiv and Receipt for a
in like manner as I could do were I
Personally Present with also Power to ap-
point other attorneys under him if necessary
to Effect the Purposes of to do all lawful
Things Respecting the Recovery of Said Land
as I could do if I were Personally Present
Reaffirming and confirming whatsoever my atty
shall lawfully do in and about the Premises
I witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 14th day of March 1799


