dits, will extend, according to their Rate and Order of Law; especially  
of well and truly administering the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Cre-  
dits, which were of the said Deceased, and making a true and perfect In-  
ventory and conscionable Appraisement thereof, and exhibiting the same  
into the Register's Office at Philadelphia, on or before the eighth  
Day of December next ensuing; and also a true and just Account,  
Calculation and Reckoning of your Administration, upon your solemn  
Oath to render at or before the eighth Day of  
November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and  
Eighty Seven or when legally thereunto required. And I do by  
these Presents ordain, constitute and depute you, the said John

Barras Administrator of all and singular the Goods and  
Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of the said Deceased, within the  
Limits aforesaid, saving harmless, and for ever indemnifying me, and all  
other Officers, against all Persons, by Reason of your Administration afore-  
said, and saving all other their Rights, &c. IN TESTIMONY whereof,
