or a quittances Discharges for me or in my name to mak fine  
Quit and deliver and further to do execute perform for me and  
finish for me and in my name all and singular things or things  
which shall be necessary touching and concerning the premises  
as fully thoroughly and intirely as if I the said James Johnston  
in my one person person might or could do in or about the same  
Concerning and allowing whatsoever my said attorney shall  
or Cause to be done in the premises by these presents in witness  
whereof I the said James Johnston have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal April 16 1787
