The said Land to have & to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges appertaining to the same to her the said Priscilla Davis her heirs & assigns to their own proper use benefit & behoof forever - and do hereby acknowledge myself the lawful owner of the premises & have full right to convey the same Witness my hand and Seal the Sixth day of August the one thousand seven hundred & Ninety two
