I now all men by these presents that Michael Jacoby for finding good cause and reasons moving hath made Ordinance and appointed and by these presents hath made Ordinance and appointed my trust friend Jacob Will of York County in whom I much confide my law & Justice attorney for me and my name & to my use to make due application at the said Office of Examiners and then & there to take out a patent for my Donation Land which I am entitled to by the terms of my Ordinance and the Register of the general Assembly in 1780 and the Act of assembly of 1792 hereby authorized and empowering my said attorney with my full power and authority to take all lawful ways & means for obtaining the same as my self might or could do were I personally present
