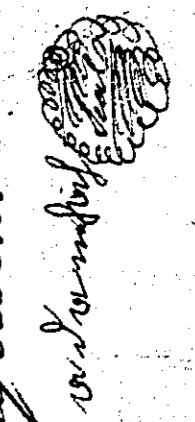

 Pennsylvania, formerly a Private Soldier, in the first
 Regiment of the Pennsylvania Line, Commanded by
 Colonel Harnar in the Service of the United
 States of America in the late War; Do make, constitute
 and appoint my trusty friend Abraham Moser of
 Windsor Township, in said County State, Yeoman, my
 true and lawful Attorney, for me and in my Name
 to lead, to my use to draw and receive any Warrant, or
 Warrant, Patent or Patents, or other legal Title for the
 Lands which I may be entitled to, do also to draw and
 receive for my life all Arrearages of Pay due to me, for
 my Services in said Regiment, agreeable to the several
 Acts of Congress in such Case made and provided,
 giving and granting to my said Attorney full Power
 and Authority to Sell, Transfer and Dispose of the same
 as he may think fit. With Power also Attorney or Attornies
 under him to make and substitute for that purpose, and to
 do all lawful Acts requisite and necessary for effecting the
 Premises; as fully and amply to all intents & purposes, as
 I my self might or could do, if I were personally present.
 And upon Receipt thereof Acquittance or other Discharges
 for me and in my name to make and execute, hereby
 Ratifying & Confirming all that my said Attorney, his
 Substitute or Substitutes, shall lawfully do, or cause to be
 done therein by Virtue of these presents. In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
 fifth Day of September, - Anno Domini One
 thousand seven hundred and Ninety seven.
