Giving and Granting unto My said Attorney all My Authority and power as fully and amply to all intents and purposes as if I Myself Were personally present. and One or More Attornies under her to Appoint and at pleasure revoke, and on Receipt of all or any part of Such Lands, Wages, donations, or Emoluments, such Receipts, Acquittances and Releases to Give and execute as the case may require. Hereby Ratifying and Confirming all and every the thing or things Which may or shall be done or perform'd by my said Attorney, in or concerning the premises. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set My Hand and Seal at Philadelphia this Seventeenth day of October. 1794. One thousand seven hundred and Eighty six. and in the Eleventh Year of American Independence
