

Fayette ff: Personally came before me the subscriber one of
the Justices of the Peace for said County Thomas
Little ^{I being duly sworn} and saith that he served as a soldier in
Colonel Mailans Regiment of Light horse five
years and ten months and that he was regularly
Discharged from said Regiment after the war was
over, - and that he parted with his Discharge to the
person to whom he sold his pay that was in arrears
And that he never sold his right to his Donation
Lands as allowed by the state of Pennsylvania nor
signed it away to any Person whomsoever,
and further saith not, — *Thos Little*
mark

holder in Colonel Mailans Regiment of Light horse in the
Commonwealth for the War in the late Revolution do
hereby Authorize and empower Royal Mage of Fayette
County in Pennsylvania, to Apply at the Proprs office
for and receive My Patent for my Donation Lands as allow-
ed by the state of Pennsylvania and sign such Receipts or
Receipts as are necessary for me and for my heirs, right-
mors, Executors I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this Eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one
Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Six. —
