Sir,

James Hamilton was appointed a Lieutenant
in a Company of Riflemen commanded by Captain John
Murray in Col. Samuel Miles' Rifle Regiment after the
Battle of Germantown. I think some time in the Month of Feby
1777 he died in the Service of his Country. Now
I Thomas Hamilton Brother and Heir of the said James
Hamilton deceased exhibit this as my Claim to the
Donation Lands granted to Officers &c. for their
Services as well for Donation Lands owing by the
State of Pennsylvania to the said Lieut. James Hamilton
or to all Gifts or Grants from the said State
to the said Lieut. James Hamilton deceased.
