Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Madari Now of the borough of Reading in the County of Berks State of Pennsylvania and late a Soldier in the American Army when at War with Great Britain do Appoint Christian Grofs of Montgomery County State aforesaid my true and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my Name and for my use to ask and demand from the State of Pennsylvania all the Lands or Land which I am Intitled to by Virtue of any Act or Acts of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for my Services rendered as a Soldier in the War above mentioned Giving and Granting unto my said Attorney by these presents my full and whole power strength and Authority in and about the premises to have use and to take all Lawfull ways and means and for the purposes above saide and upon the Receipt of any such Lands to pass any such Requisite Receipt or Acknowledgment for the same hereby ratifying allowing and holding for firm all and whatsoever my said
