I do by these presents ordain, constitute and depute you the said

Administratrix of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said decedent
within the limits aforesaid, saving harmless and for ever indemnifying me and all other
Officers against all other persons by reason of your Administration aforesaid, and
