belong or of right appertain unto me, I give, devise, & bequeath  
unto my said Wife Elizabeth. - And I do hereby nominate  
and appoint my Son George, & my said Wife Elizabeth to  
be sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, hereby  
revoking all former Wills and Testaments by me made  
and do declare this to be my last Will - In Witness  
whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 15.<sup>th</sup>  
day of April Anno. Domini 1780.
