Gentlemen

I have reason to believe that there is a considerable interference between the sixth and seventh Denotum Districts: probably one hundred perches or upwards on a north and south direction. I was called on once by the owner of a Tract of land in the seventh Denotum to show him the lines of his Tract. It appeared by the draught in my possession to be on the second range from the south verge of the seventh District and nearly about the place that Mr. Gready mentions to me that a tract has been drawn. I could find no lines nor corners on the south range of the seventh District in that neighbourhood. This has been corroborated to me by James Douglas a Surveyor who endeavored to find the lines of a tract of land shown for a man in Westmoreland County last session by Mr. Gready. I mentioned what appeared to be the circumstances to Mr. Douglas before he made the attempt who after his return confirmed my impressions of the matter. Yours respectfully
