KNOW ALL MEN By these Presents that *J. Thomas M. Lord* in the service of the United States, for a full and valuable Consideration to me in hand well and truly paid by *Abraham Foster* of the County of *Bucks* before the sealing and delivery hereof; the Receipt whereof

do hereby acknowledge, have and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell, assign, release, and confirm, unto the said *Abraham Foster* and to his heirs and assigns, forever; all my estate, right, title, interest, use, possession, proper claim, and demand, whatever, which I now have to all and singular the lands, pay, arrearages of pay, Clothing, Rations, gratuities or other demands, due and owing to me from the United States, or from any particular State, for my Services as aforesaid. To have and to hold, all and singular the above mentioned and assigned premises, with the appurtenances, unto him the said *Abraham Foster* his heirs and assigns forever; and

do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said *Abraham Foster* his heirs and assigns, my true and lawful attorney, irrevocably to ask, demand, recover and receive of and from the United States, or from any particular State whatsoever, or from any person or persons acting by, from, or under their or any of theirs authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrearages of pay, rations, Gratuities, and other demands, whatsoever due and owing to me as aforesaid; and to receive and accept the same by grant or otherwise, in his or their own names, and to his or their own proper use and behoof forever; and also to sign seal and execute good and sufficient discharge for the same, in due form of Law.
