-vania line during the war with Great Britain
Do constitute and appoint my Trusty friend
John Anderson of the Borough of Carlisle to be
my True and lawful Attorney for me and in
my Name to ask demand and Receive from
the Land Office of the state of Pennsylvania
my Donation lands promised to the late
Army; and to ask demand and Receive
from the Secretary at War for the United States
my Military land warrant for One Hundred
Acres of land (also) promised to the late Army
; Giving to my said attorney my full power
to ask demand Receive and Receipt for the
same as fully, as I would, or could do were
I personally present. In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal
This Thirtieth day of May A.D. 1794
