and to his heirs and assigns for ever

giving and granting unto my said attorney, by these presents, my full power,
strength, and authority, in and about the premises, to have, use, and take, all law-
ful ways and means, in my name, for the recovery thereof, and upon the receipt
of any such debts, dues, or any other thing or things, acquittances or other dis-
charges, for me and in my name to make, seal, and deliver all and every other
act and acts in the law whatsoever, necessary to be done in and about the premises,
as fully, largely, and amply, to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do,
if I was personally present; and I do also empower my said attorney by these pre-
sents, to make one or more substitutes under him, for the purposes above mentioned.
