Personally appeared before me John ex. Know  
deu one of the Justices of the Peace for the County  
and State aforesaid, Alexander McKee, who being  
duly sworn, doth say, that he had a brother name  
James McKee who, he understood, to have served as a  
sergeant or soldier in the Pennsylvania Line, in  
the Co's Hammer, 6th Regiment, during the revolution  
ary war — and that this aforesaid hath learned  
that his said brother hath been dead nearly or  
teen years — that he hath left a widow (Mary M.  
Kee) and two daughters to wit Martha who is since  
intermarried with William Birch and Susan  
since intermarried with James Rogan — and  
that they all reside in the County of Butler  
and State of Pennsylvania. And this aforesaid fur  
ther saith, that during the life time of his said bro
