she was never certain of his Death until late
which was proven by Edward Davis belonging
to D^e Company's Regiment; A^d proof was made
before Capt Grover Bedelhouse; —

Charaliffe; the Copy of y^e Oath is not
now present your Petitioner is ever bound
to pray —
