


Know all men by these presents that I Hugh Means of the Town of Washington

I am or may be entitled from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
as Ensign in the Ranging company of Bedford County in the State aforesaid
commanded by Captain John Boyd and also to take and receive of whom
as therefor and acquittance or release in my name to give and
generally to and transact all matters and things touching the premises in
my name as fully and completely as if I were personally present
hereby ratifying and conforming whatsoever my said attorney
may or shall do touching the same. In testimony whereof

twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord
the thousand seven hundred & ninety two
