 doeth hereby otherwise constitute and appoint my trustee and wellbeloved
 friend the honorable William Finley Esqir Member of the Hon.
 house of Congress of the United States of America in Philadelphia
 as my lawfull Attorney to appear at the office in the City of Philadelphia
 for the Distribution of the Donation Lands for the troops of the
 Pennsylvania line agreeable to the laws of said State therein provided
 then and there to appear for me and in my behalf and to act and do
 for me as if I was there personally present and to receive for me
 all such Rights as by law is provided in such case as if I was there
 personally present in all things required by the laws aforesaid. and to
 give and to receive such Receipts or other writings or other Documents
 as are requisite or required by law for the same to all which I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs and administrators and assigns to him his heirs and assigns
 to all which I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth Day of
 February one thousand seven hundred and Ninety six 1796

 the Justices of the Peace for said County of Franklin and being sworn as the
 laws Direct doeth and testify that he is the same Zachor Meigs
 that was intitled by said Walter. Sheward and served in the
 Regiment of the Pennsylvania Line for near four years under
 the Command of the Regiment Comanded by Col. Sheward and that
 he received his Discharge from the Regiment by General Anthony Wayne Dated
 January 14 1781 but that he did not receive his Discharge
 until and then he did take the same and subscribed February 20 1796
 before us John Andrew
