


Know all Men By these Presents, That I *William Griffey*
late a Soldier in first Regiment of Pennsylvania troops

in the service of the United States of America for value and the full consideration money to me
in hand paid, at, and before the execution hereof by *Frederick Molineux*
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE, and hereby Do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, con-
vey and confirm unto *Frederick Molineux, his* heirs, executors,
administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity,
which I now have, or which *my* heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have
to the lands, ~~any, depreciation, clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize-moneys,~~ and every
other arrearage, claim and demand whatever due and owing *me* from and by the United States or
any particular state, and I do hereby for *myself my* heirs, executors and administrators cove-
nant and agree, to and with the said *Frederick Molineux his* heirs,
executors, administrators and assigns that *my* heirs, executors, and administrators, will, at any
time hereafter at the reasonable cost and charges of *the said Frederick Molineux, his*
heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assur-
ances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the
premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make constitute and ap-
point *the said Frederick Molineux my*
true and lawful attorney; irrevocable to demand and receive sue for, and recover from the United States,
or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority,
all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and fold, and now
withheld and detained from *me by the United States the State of Pennsylvania*
or either or any of them for and on account of my services as aforesaid
with power, also attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts
requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that *my* said attorney or
his substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
