ing unto my said Attorney by their presents my full and
whole power thought and Authority in and about the
Premises to have Use and to take all Lawfull ways and
means in my name and for the purpose aforesaid and
upon the Receipt of any such Lands moneys or other
commodities to pay pay requisite receipt or Acknowledgment
for the same and also to appoint one or more Attorney
under him for the purposes above mentioned And
again at pleasure Recede Hereby ratifying allowing
and holding for firm all and whatsoever my said
attorney shall Lawfully do in and about the premises
