Thomas Denton his Heirs and Assigns, to the only
proper Use and behoof of the said Thomas Denton
his Heirs and Assigns forever. And the said
Major James Parr for himself and his Heirs, Executors
and Administrators doth covenant promise and grant
to and with the said Thomas Denton his Heirs & Assigns
and every of them by these presents in Manner and Form
following; that is to say, That he the said James Parr
and his Heirs, the aforesaid five Hundred Acres of Land
Hereditaments and Premises hereby granted and sold
or mentioned or intended to be with the Appurtenances
unto the said Thomas Denton his Heirs and Assigns,
Against him the said James Parr and his Heirs, and
against all and every other Person or Persons whatsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim by from or under him them
or any of them shall and will Warrant and forever
Defend by these presents. And further that
he the said James Parr and his Heirs and all and every
